
RAINBOW BRIDGES




What's New at CUBE?

Our mission has been to support schools in building safe, respectful environments where consent is understood, practiced, and taught, not just as a topic, but as a way of relating to others

News

Over the course of the project, partners from Germany, Portugal, Bulgaria, Croatia, Ireland, France, and Greece worked together to develop and test practical resources that empower educators, students, and parents to talk about consent in meaningful and ageappropriate ways.

The Act4Consent project reached hundreds of educators, parents, and students across six countries.

Participants reported increased awareness, skills, and confidence when it comes to discussing and teaching consent.


