Students in Isernia Lead the Fight Against Antigypsyism

Isernia – Students have taken center stage in the fight against antigypsyism through the #AcadeMe https://academe-project.eu/ and #RomniMe projects, funded under the European program CERV-2023-EQUAL.

Guided by mentors Giuseppe and Concetta Sarachella, together with councilor Sara Ferri, the young participants followed a sevenmodule training path. Topics ranged from the history of Roma communities and stereotypes to fake news, online hate speech, and gender equality, with special focus on empowering Roma girls.

The program concluded with a meeting with national coordinator Saska Jovanovic and Bljerim Fetahi, president of Romni APS, reinforcing the link between local youth and European initiatives.

We are pleased to share the first AMIR Project Newsletter.

The project has now officially entered its implementation phase. After six months of preparation, national working groups – including the one in Cyprus, led by CODECA– produced reports highlighting local challenges in employment, housing, and financial education. These findings informed the joint European Integration Strategy, which was presented at the transnational meeting in Barcelona on 15–16 July 2025.

The project is coordinated by Comunità Papa Giovanni XXIII (Italy), with partners from Spain, Hungary, Germany, France, Sweden, Greece, and Cyprus. It is funded by the EU under AMIF-2023-TF2-AG-CALL.

This final meeting not only celebrated the achievements of the partnership but also paved the way for further integration of El into European VET systems.
