

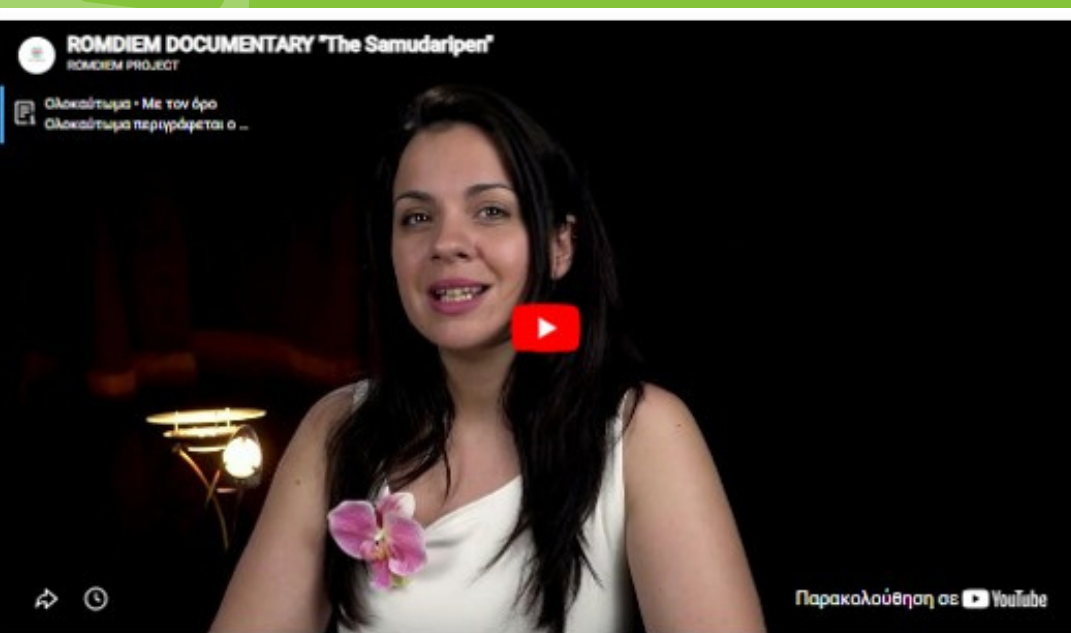

The ROMDIEM Documentary is Out!

The **ROMDIEM Documentary** is now available, offering a powerful journey through one of the least known chapters of European history—the Roma Holocaust (Samudaripen).



Blending personal testimonies, historical research, artistic expression, and contemporary reflections, the documentary gives voice to survivors' descendants, historians, educators, artists, and Roma community members from across Europe. More than a historical film, it is a tribute to resilience, memory, and the importance of preserving stories that have too often remained unheard.

What makes the documentary unique is its **creative storytelling**, combining documentary filmmaking with theatre, music, visual arts, and performance to create an emotional and thought-provoking experience for audiences of all generations.

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A Successful European Online Premiere

The documentary premiered online with an overwhelming response, attracting 351 registrations and welcoming **more than 200 participants from across Europe**. Representatives of civil society, academia, educational institutions, public authorities, media, and Roma communities came together to reflect on the legacy of the Roma Holocaust and the importance of remembrance, inclusion, and human rights.

Following the premiere, project partners organised national feedback sessions and discussions, creating space for dialogue, reflection, and the exchange of ideas on how historical memory can help combat discrimination and build a more inclusive Europe.

The ROMDIEM Documentary is more than a film—it is **an invitation to remember, reflect, and ensure** that these stories are never forgotten.



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
